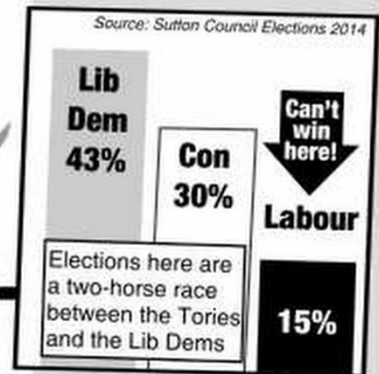

## **BLenheim ROAD PLANNING APPEAL**

An appeal has been lodged against the Council's refusal of planning permission at 42 Blenheim Rd for:

Erection of a three bedroom detached dwelling with provision of three parking spaces, new vehicular access and cycle and refuse store. Provision of a car parking space and access to donor dwelling.

This planning application (No. 75513), which is for a separate house in the garden of No 42, was refused by the Council as 'its design, appearance and site coverage would constitute an incongruous and unsympathetic form of development which would be out of keeping with the prevailing character of Blenheim Road.' And 'by reason of the proposed crossovers, would result in the loss on-street car parking spaces which would adversely impact on parking in the surrounding area.'

As reported previously the Government's Planning Inspectorate recently granted an appeal for the demolition of No 42 and the erection of a two storey 4 bedroomed house with roof accommodation, car parking, cycle and refuse stores on that site, with new vehicular access onto Blenheim Road. Applicants have the right to appeal to the Planning Inspector, which acts on behalf of the government. Everyone who was originally consulted or commented on the application will be advised of the appeal. Copies of all the original letters of representation are also passed to the inspector.
