Tackling speeding traffic

Many residents have contacted us about speeding traffic in our area.

It's made more dangerous by the number of cars parked in our narrow roads.

Although Collingwood Road has a 20mph limit, it is not always observed and parents taking children to Westbourne School have expressed concern about road safety.

We are organising a meeting to discuss the issue with traffic officers, the police and the bus company (as speeding buses at night are also an issue).

Residents in Rosehill Park West have also raised the problem and



we have surveyed them to get their views on a range of solutions. In Sutton Common Road we have asked for the 30mph warning signs to be replaced with countdown 'smiley face' signs. Please let us know if speeding traffic is a problem in your road, using the details provided.

Garden suburb allotment update

A planning application has been received to build eight houses on the former allotments site between Greenhill, Woodend, and Aultone Way. This application is a departure from (ie goes against) the Local Plan as the allotments site is protected as Urban Green Space and we are keeping local residents updated.

Prince Regent pub update

Thanks to all who have contacted us to express support for keeping this historic pub.

Sutton Council recently agreed to place the pub on its list of 'locally

listed' buildings. Council policy is to encourage the retention, repair and reuse of Locally Listed Buildings and this action identifies the pub as an historic building that should be retained.
