CAN YOU HELP US WITH EVIDENCE OF LORRIES USING VALE ROAD TO ACCESS THE GAS WORKS SITE?

The planning consent for the gasworks site prohibits the use of Vale Road as an access for heavy vehicles. Also Vale Road has a general weight restriction. Despite this residents have complained many times that heavy lorries have been using Vale Road to gain access to the site.

Recently the developers on the Old Gas Works and the Burger King sites have denied that their lorries are using Vale Road.


The Council's Highways Officer will be meeting the developers next Wednesday 23 Sept to resolve this issue. We have asked him to consider permanently closing the site access from Vale Road for all vehicles, improving the signage at the High St junction to direct traffic clearly into the main entrance, and requiring the developers to position a traffic marshal at that junction.

Council officers have asked for clear evidence of the planning condition being broken, that they can use at their meeting. This evidence needs to be specific.

So, do you have recent information on heavy lorries using Vale Road to access the site? By this we mean dates, times, registration numbers, the names of any companies and any photos. The evidence needs to be specific enough to enable the perpetrators to be identified.

If so please send it to your local Councillors Ruth, Marlene and Steve by email or to Civic Office, St Nicholas Way, Sutton, SM1 1EA by noon on Monday 21st, and we will pass it to the Highways Officer.

Thank you for your help. We'll continue to monitor the situation and let you know the outcome of the meeting
