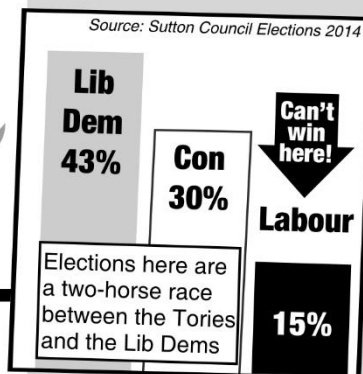

GAS WORKS DEVELOPMENT: PAVEMENT CLOSURES IN 2016

The works continue to make progress and we hope that the changes to the access arrangements have provided some relief. You will have had an update in the recent developer's newsletter and councillors attended the residents' meetings on 9 December.

To facilitate the Linden Homes construction there will be some parking bay and pavement closures during next year. This is in three separate phases:

PHASE 1

4th January to 26th February

Eight Pay and Display bays suspended, leaving the four bays nearest the High Street available.

Footpath closed along the front of the site (but not where the bays are open) up to number 17 Vale Road.

PHASE 2

26th February to 14th October

All bays back in operation

Footpath open, builders working from scaffolding above.

PHASE 3

14th October to 9th December

All 12 bays suspended. Footpath shut from High Street to number 17 Vale Road. This enables the pavement to be rebuilt.

Everything will be back to normal from 10th December.

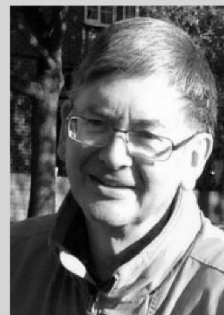
