42 BLENHEIM ROAD: APPEAL ALLOWED

We are disappointed that the Government's Planning Inspectorate has overturned Sutton's Council decision and allowed an appeal for the erection of a three bedroom house with associated parking, landscaping, refuse and cycle storage, and new vehicular accesses to Blenheim Road.

This appeal relates to application, DM2018/00250, which was refused by Sutton Council on 6 July last year.

The inspector notes that there have been five previous appeals relating to different proposals for this site, four have been dismissed and one allowed. He says that while he has had regard to these decisions, the detail of the current appeal is materially different.

Sutton Council turned down this application as: "The proposal would cause material harm and would represent an overdevelopment of the site, resulting in a cramped development, reducing the level of amenity space, leading to an adverse effect on the area."

The Planning Inspectorate took a different view. 'Whilst the proposed dwelling is detached, its scale and design would not make it appear incongruous in the street scene and it would not interrupt the rhythm of the development along Blenheim Road. Further, the plot size of both the existing and new dwelling would be very similar to others in the road, leading me to conclude that it would not appear as overdevelopment of the site and as a result there would be no adverse effect on the character and appearance of the area'. He also says: 'I find that the dwelling would provide acceptable levels of private amenity space for the future occupiers of the dwelling. Similarly, there is no evidence before me that the remaining private amenity space for No 42 would not be adequate to meet the needs of its occupants.'
