### PARKING CONSULTATION IN GREENHILL

As your local councillors we are still fighting to maximise the parking space available to local residents, while making sure parking is safe and does not block access to roads or drives. In the first consultation on parking, held in 2017, most replies supported a residents' parking zone in your area. As a result the Council consulted on a Controlled Parking Zone late last year.

Many have since told us that you support these proposals. Some have raised concerns about the need to park across their own dropped kerbs, and the resulting loss of parking space. Some felt the double yellow line around the island at the Greenhill/ Woodend junction was not justified.

An alternative would be a Parking Permit Area. This is a residents' permit scheme, but without bays or yellow lines, except where needed for safety:

- Only residents with a permit can park on the road
- Hours could be 8am to 5.30pm Mon to Fri.
- Residents can park over dropped kerbs
- Permit costs are from £40 a year (77p a week), depending on the car: among the lowest in London
- Whether or not you buy a parking permit you get 50 hours (a year

   ie one hour a week) of free visitor parking vouchers. Extra
  vouchers cost £61 for 100 (ie 60p each). Vouchers only needed
  when the PPA scheme is in operation ie not evenings and
  weekends, when parking is free.
- The money from the permits pays for enforcement officers


The PPA would be signed at the entrances to Aultone Way and Woodend with some repeater signs.

Double yellow lines would still be needed around the Aultone Way roundabouts for road safety reasons, but not at the Greenhill/ Woodend 'island'.


