PARKING CONSULTATION IN WAVERLEY AVENUE

As your local councillors we are still fighting to maximise the parking space available to local residents, while making sure parking is safe and does not block access to roads or drives. The bottom of Waverley Avenue particularly suffers from commuter parking, which can make access to the road difficult.

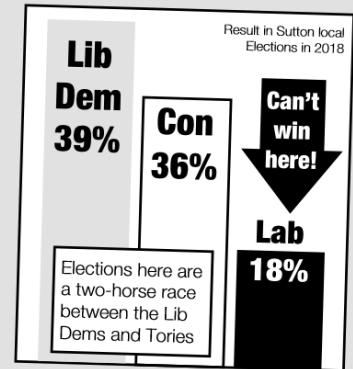
Residents will be aware of the proposal for a new school in the park, and if this goes ahead, parking in Waverley Avenue could get worse.

At the end of last year, the Council consulted on proposals for a double yellow line on the south side, between Angel Hill Drive and Montrose Gardens, with free parking bays on the north side together with single yellow lines across dropped kerbs (which would prevent parking from 8.00 to 10am and 3pm to 5pm, from Mon to Sat). This gained some support, but views were mixed and we would welcome your further views before any decisions are taken.

Would residents support just having a double yellow line on the evens side of the road from the corner with Angel Hill Drive up to the corner with Montrose Gardens and no other restrictions?
