Speeding Concerns on Collingwood Road - Survey

We continue to be concerned about the speed of traffic in Collingwood Road, the use of the road by heavy lorries, in defiance of the ban of vehicles over 7.5 tonnes, and the use of the road by buses through the night.

These problems have led to road safety concerns – important as parents walk children to Westbourne Primary School; safety issues crossing the road; noise keeping people awake at night; pollution; and vibration which may have led to cracks in some people's houses.

Speeding traffic is a matter for the police, and at our request they have been holding more regular Community Speedwatch events – using mobile cameras to detect speeding traffic.

A camera has been installed, at our request, near the entrance to Collingwood Rec to record the number of heavy vehicles. Unfortunately we cannot set up a speed enforcement camera as the government regulations only permit this when there is evidence of a high number of serious road traffic accidents.

We have involved Caroline Pidgeon in this issue. She is a member on the London Assembly at City Hall and is deputy chair of their Transport Committee. She has got Transport for London to agree to remove the confusing 30 mph and 16.5 Tonne weight limit signs, so that Sutton's signs of 20mph and 7.5 Tonnes are clearly visible.

For us to be able to make further improvements to Collingwood Road we will need to bid for more resources. THIS IS WHERE WE NEED YOUR HELP PLEASE...
