We have seen news reports that traffic in Outer London has increased considerably over the last few weeks

due to people's understandable reluctance to use public transport for school, work and other journeys. As a London borough we have poor access to Underground and Overground networks which means more people rely on their cars. We need to understand how we can protect our residential roads from cut through traffic and encourage more drivers to use the main roads.



### **Government to decide** on school in Rosehill **Park in February**

The Planning Appeal into the new school on Rosehill Park has now finished. The Government is appealing against Sutton Council's refusal to grant planning permission.

Steve argued that the park was highly valued by the local community: 'We are providing a superb parkland setting. In return we need a building that respects the heritage of its environment, and will inspire its students.'

## **Collingwood Road residents campaign** for safety measure



We continue to be concerned about the speed of traffic in Collingwood Road, the use of the road by heavy lorries, and by buses through the night.

The police have been using mobile cameras to detect speeding traffic, and a camera has been recording heavy vehicles.

Transport for London are to remove their confusing signs at the by-pass entrance, so that the 20mph and 7.5Tonnes signs are clearly visible.

We are now surveying residents in the road on what further measures they would support.
