With your local councillor team in Sutton North: Cllr Ruth Dombey, Cllr Marlene Heron and Cllr Steve Penneck

You are invited to meet the managers of Sutton bus garage on-line

We have been talking to residents about the problems caused by the buses using Collingwood Road to get to the bus garage, especially late at night. As a result, Transport for London and Go-Ahead have invited residents from Collingwood Road to meet with them on-line to discuss the issue of bus traffic in the road.

The meeting is on Thursday 4 March at 7pm and will use Microsoft Teams.

We have been talking with the bus companies about the concerns of residents about:

- The number of 'not in service' buses, especially at night
- The speed of buses in the road
- The use of the road by fuel tankers accessing the bus garage
- The proposal to use only double deckers for the 80 service

Please do attend the meeting if you can to give your views on these issues. They have asked for questions, if possible, to be submitted in advance by using Slido: <https://app.slido.event/msbbpc> or use the QR code on the accompanying leaflet.

The bus managers will start the meeting by presenting their views on the issues, then there will be time for questions.

Councillors are also aware of the wider questions of speeding traffic and heavy vehicles using the road. The focus of the meeting next Thursday will be on the buses. A variable speed indicator sign will be installed in the road in the next few weeks and we continue to press for funding for a 'bus gate' camera (to capture heavy vehicles) to be installed at the by-pass end.
