Charging Points for Electric Vehicles – Rectory Road

Sutton Council is working with Siemens to install Ubitricity lamp column electric vehicle charging points to enable residents to easily charge electric or plug-in hybrid vehicles on the street where they live, especially if they do not have off-street parking.


These columns are becoming commonplace on residential streets in London and are being installed with financial assistance from OZEV (Office for Zero Emission Vehicles) and GULCS (London's Go Ultra Cities Scheme).

Signage will indicate that the column has a charging point fitted but the sign will not prevent other vehicles from parking next to the lamp column. Current parking restrictions will apply and will be unaffected by the charging point.
