SAFETY MEASURES & DISABLED BAY IMPLEMENTED AT LAST!

After months of delays due to highways officers being on Covid duties caused by the pandemic, implementing the Parking Strategy had to take a back seat. The lining contractor made an awful mistake in Ranfurly Road that had to be rectified. Double yellow lines painted one side of the St. John's Road following a report by the Fire Service that their appliance couldn't gain access to the road to extinguish a fire. Unfortunately double yellow lines were painted on the same side of the road where a disabled bay was needed. The lining could not be completed properly as there was a parked car in the way and the owner was unable to move it. This proved to be fortuitous and Cllr Marlene Heron urged the highways engineers to think outside the box to move the double yellow lines to the opposite side of the road and install the disabled bay closer to the resident who needs it with some parking spaces for other vehicles.

By law there had to be a Traffic Management Order setting out the proposals for consultation with residents which had to be analysed and the revised scheme was put in place last week. Marlene's perseverance paid off as now there is room for emergency vehicles and delivery vans to access this narrow residential road safely.


Local resident, Mrs W, commented:
